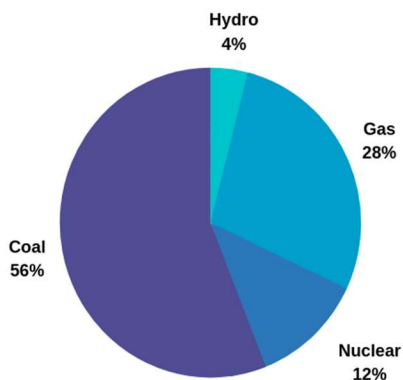
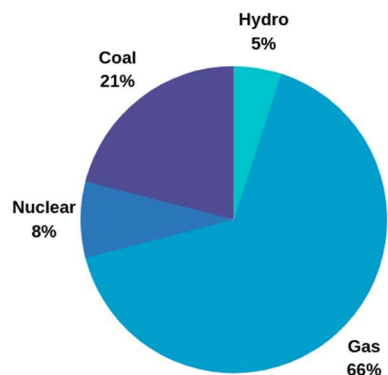

### **Energy Fuel Source Mix**

Cooperative Energy, headquartered in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, is Delta Electric’s Generation and Transmission Cooperative that supplies 100% of Delta Electric’s wholesale power. Delta Electric does not generate any of its own power for resale. The above charts show the energy fuel source mix for generation from Cooperative Energy for years 2005 and 2018. In 2005, coal was the dominant fuel source at 56% with natural gas at 28% of total fuel. By 2018, natural gas had replaced coal as the dominant fuel source at 66% of total fuel with coal falling to 21%. The only coal generation plant owned by Cooperative Energy was closed in December 2018 and will be repurposed as a natural gas combined cycle plant. Renewable energy will become a significant part of Cooperative Energy’s energy sources with the addition of the 52 Megawatt MS Solar 3 generating facility in Lamar County during 2018 and the 100 Megawatt Delta’s Edge solar facility in Carroll County slated for commissioning in 2022.
